	<p><b>Tunnelling</b></p> <p><u>TBMs and cross passages</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Both TBMs have broken through into the Shafston mainline tunnels previously excavated by roadheader</li> <li>• Blasting of the low point sump (approx Medina) is complete</li> <li>• Cross passage (XP) excavation is complete north of the river</li> <li>• XP continues in Kangaroo Point</li> <li>• Smoke duct work continues north of the river</li> </ul> <p><u>Shafston</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Concrete lining work and tunnel fit out continues</li> </ul>

There is a catchment area for rain events (stormwater retention tank).</p> <p><i>Member asked if the smoke duct is a separate tunnel.</i></p> <p>AW advised the smoke duct is in the ceiling of the tunnel and will be used in case of a fire.</p>
