UPDATE - GIBBON STREET SHED DEMOBILISATION, WOOLLOONGABBA

Duration of work: February - April

Shed Removal

From Monday 22 February until April 2010 work to remove the shed at the CLEM7 Gibbon Street site will occur.

The following activities will be required as part of this work:

- out of hours movements of oversized loads from and to the site,
- removal of shed cladding and structural steel,
- removal of the all site facilities and equipment,
- excavation of concrete foundations,
- reinstatement of the site and fencing,
- tidying and maintenance work.

Intermittent changed traffic conditions will occur during the day and night as part of this work.

Traffic control will be in attendance to assist motorists and pedestrians during out of hours work.

For occupational health and safety reasons, reversing beepers can not be switched off.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Night and out of hours work.
- Use of heavy machinery.
- Out of hours removal of equipment.
- Changed traffic conditions.
- Noise from construction activities including the use of rockbreakers, jackhammers and handheld tools.
- Increased truck movements.

Please be advised that adverse weather conditions may affect work schedules and activities.

WHAT WE WILL DO

- Maintain access to private properties at all times.
- Use traffic control when required during construction activities.
- Minimise noise wherever possible.
