Duration of work: 23 November 2009

Tunnel Roof Construction

Construction of the tunnel roof within the Gibbon Street shaft is now in its final stages.

On **Monday 23 November** the final major concrete pour to construct the tunnel roof will occur.

Due to the length and nature of the pour and strength of concrete required work will commence at 4.00am and continue throughout the day until early evening.

Changed traffic conditions will be required on Gibbon Street as part of this work.

Access to properties and businesses will be maintained at all times.

Once the tunnel roof is complete backfilling of the shaft will commence in early December and is expected to be complete by January 2010.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Out of hours, day and night work.
- Use of heavy machinery.
- Increased truck movements.
- Delivery of material and equipment to site.
- General construction noise.

For occupational health and safety reasons, reversing beepers can not be switched off.

WHAT WE WILL DO

- Complete work as quickly as possible.
- Maintain access to properties at all times.
- Minimise noise from activities and machinery wherever possible by installing additional noise mitigation measures.
