PRECAST CONCRETE BEAM AND SLAB DELIVERIES – GIBBON STREET, WOOLLOOGABBA

Duration of work: 4 – 6 October 2009

Tunnel Roof Construction

From **Sunday 4 until Tuesday 6 October** precast concrete beams and slabs will be delivered at night to the Gibbon Street site, as part of ongoing tunnel construction.

The concrete beams and slabs will be lowered into the shaft to form the tunnel roof and smoke duct.

This work will require changed traffic conditions on Gibbon Street.

Traffic control will be in attendance to assist motorists and pedestrians during construction activities.

Ongoing concrete pours will continue throughout October as part of the smoke duct construction.

These pours will commence during the day and may be required to extend into the evening due to the length and nature of the pour and strength of concrete required.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Out of hours and night work.
- Use of heavy machinery.
- Increased truck movements.
- Delivery of material and equipment to site.
- General construction noise.

For occupational health and safety reasons, reversing beepers can not be switched off.

WHAT WE WILL DO

- Maintain access to properties at all times.
- Complete work as quickly as possible.
- Minimise noise from activities and machinery wherever possible.
- Continue to keep you informed of ongoing work.
