## GIBBON STREET UPDATE – COMPLETION OF TBM REMOVAL

**Duration of work:** Ongoing throughout 2009

On Thursday 13 August the last section of the tunnel boring machine was removed from the Gibbon Street shaft marking the end of major tunnelling activities on the CLEM7 project.

Work at the Gibbon Street site now moves into the final phase, and includes construction of the tunnel roofs, backfilling of the shaft and the eventual dismantling of the large shed and worker facilities.

Construction activities over the next few months will include:

- completion of cross passages and substation excavation,
- installing drainage and conduits within the tunnel,
- undertaking large concrete pours to create the tunnel roof within the shaft,
- delivery of precast concrete panels, fill and other materials to complete the roof and backfill the shaft.

As part of this work delivery of materials and equipment to and from the site will occur. Where possible every effort will be made to limit access via Gibbon Street and use the tunnel entrance from Ipswich Road.

Changed traffic conditions will occur under traffic control.

### WHAT TO EXPECT

- Delivery of materials and equipment to and from site.
- Out of hours and night work within the shaft.
- Use of heavy machinery.
- General construction noise.
- Occasional changed traffic conditions.

### WHAT WE WILL DO

- Wherever possible undertake noisy work during the day or early evening.
- Use traffic control /spotters to assist motorists and pedestrian during construction activities.
- Maintain access to properties and businesses at all times.
