CONTROLLED TUNNEL TESTING – WOOLLOONGABBA TO BOWEN HILLS

Duration of work: 12 – 19 February 2010

Controlled Tunnel Testing

From **Friday 12 until Friday 19 February** controlled commissioning tests will occur at night in the CLEM7 tunnel in preparation for its opening.

Artificial smoke will be used to test the safety features of the tunnel and you may see this smoke rising from the north and south ventilation stations.

Changed traffic conditions will occur at the tunnel entry and exit points at Woolloongabba, Bowen Hills and Kangaroo Point.

Some of the controlled commissioning tests will involve simulated incidents/accidents and include emergency service personnel and vehicles.

The CLEM7 Community Open Day will be held on Sunday 28 February 2010.
