UPDATE: CONSTRUCTION OF UNDERGROUND ROAD PAVEMENT – KANGAROO POINT

Duration of work: From 12 October to 31 October, intermittently at night.

Following completion of tunnel excavation earlier this year work in the tunnel continues 24 hours a day 7 days a week to install lighting, road pavements, traffic barriers and reflective wall lining panels.

Currently work is occurring underground to construct the final road pavement. The first layer of road pavement is constructed of asphalt and the final layer is constructed of concrete.

The asphalt layer requires compaction with a small vibratory roller, which may cause some very low levels of vibration and regenerated noise. This work may be noticeable for short periods of time.

The map overleaf indicates the location of the underground road pavement construction.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Possible low levels of noise.
- Possible low levels of vibration.
- Small vibratory roller operating intermittently at night.

WHAT WE WILL DO

- Notify for possible effects of underground construction activities.
